Re: Y4 Visit to the DEWA Roman Experience in Chester

We have arranged a trip to the Dewa Roman Experience to view their Roman History Exhibition and take part in a workshop on 9 October 2018. The children will take part in a fully guided tour of the reconstructions, excavations, museum and discover what it took to become part of the Roman Army.

This visit will feature specially tailored activities and learning opportunities for primary school children, which will directly link to the topic work we have been doing in class.

School would appreciate a voluntary contribution of £11.50 to cover the cost of transport and the cost of the workshops.
