

## Literacy

We will start by reading 'How to wash a woolly mammoth' we will be using this as stimulus to write our own set of instructions 'How to wash a sabre-tooth cat' We will look at the correct use of articles a and an. We will also look at how we can use adverbs to add extra detail to our writing.

We will also read the story 'Glog' We will use this to help us to write our own adventure story about a Stone age boy. We will be focussing on the use of adjectives to describe and how to use fronted adverbials to help us to open our sentences in different ways.

## Maths

In maths we will be thinking about Place Value and the use of HTO to help us to partition numbers. We will be ordering and comparing number up to 1000. In addition to this we will start to look at addition and subtraction up to 1000.

We will also be paying particular attention to our 3, 4 and 8 x tables to start to rapidly recall these in order to answer TTR questions.

## Music

This half term we will be finding out about rhythm and pulse in a range of pieces of music. We will investigate a range of genres of music and try to use body percussion to keep the pulse

## History

Our main topic focuses on changes in Britain from the Stone age to the Iron age.

Some of the areas that we will be covering will be: Hunter-gatherers and how they helped to provide food for the families

- Animals that were around during the stone age and pre human history
- How technology has changed from the early Palaeolithic era to the end of the Iron Age.
- Tools that were used and how these have changed over time
- Dwellings and other houses that were created across the Palaeolithic, Mesolithic and Neolithic

## DT

We will be looking into the history of music and how the Neanderthals made drums. We will be then thinking about how to create our own drum.

## ICT

We will be looking at how to stay safe online this half term. We will be finding out about Cyberbullying and how we can identify it and what to do if it happens. We will also be finding out about the type of information we should share and which we should keep to ourselves online.

## PE

We will be looking at planning and creating a piece of dance using music from around the world as stimulus. In Outdoor PE we will be learning some skills to play a simple game of cricket. ## Science

This half term we will be looking at rocks and soils.

- Group rocks based on their appearance and simple physical properties
- explain in simple terms how fossils are formed when things that have lived are trapped in a rock
- recognise that rocks are made from rocks and organic matter

## RE

We will be using the Oldham agreed syllabus to support our teaching of RE. We will be investigating how beliefs are different across 3 main religions, Judaism, Islam and Christianity and how people who don't follow a religion still have beliefs that they follow.
