- We will work on listening to others within play and share their views.
- Continue to extend our vocabulary across all areas of the curriculum.
- Answer questions about picture and video stimuli.

Personal, Social & Emotional

- Confidently try new activities and say why they like some activities more than others.
- Participate in team activities such as building obstacle courses to improve problem solving skills and social skills.
- To be able to negotiate and solve problems with others in a correct way.

Physical Development

- Move confidently over small PE equipment
- Increase understanding of the need for safety when tackling new challenges.
- Begin to manage some risks without direct support.

Literacy

- Develop further knowledge of how stories are structured.
- Develop letter sound/grapheme correspondence.
- Read and understand some simple captions and sentences.
- Become more independent in writing.
- Begin to write some simple sentences.



Maths

- Mastering numbers to 20 and using them for addition and subtraction.
- Counting on and counting back.
- Practice doubling, halving and sharing.

- Talk about pets they have or would like and how they differ to those of others.
- Use ICT hardware to interact with age-appropriate software of the IWB and iPads.
