

### Communication and Language

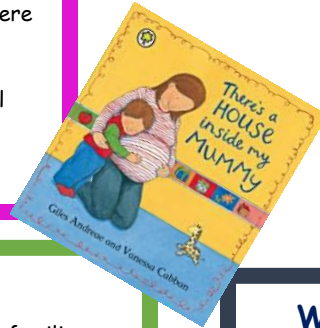
We will ask questions like, "What can you do now you are 3? Now you are 4?"

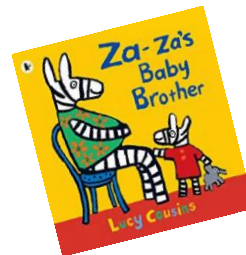


### Mathematics

We will create repeating patterns and understand positional language



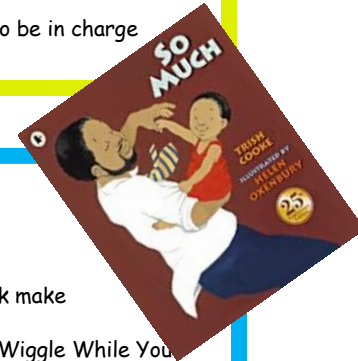
### Personal, Social and Emotional Development
