Dear Parents/Carers

From Tuesday 9th May the Year 6 children will be taking their end of Key Stage 2 SATs tests. They have been working incredibly hard all year and we are extremely proud of the progress they have made, along with the mature way in which they have shown they want to try their best.

Over the year, the children have sat a number of practise tests to try and make them feel as comfortable as possible when it comes to SATs week itself. We have also been using these practise sessions to identify what the optimum conditions will be for each child taking the test. This may mean that your child takes their test in a smaller group situation, 1:1 with an adult or in a larger group to try and make them feel as confident as possible when it comes to sitting the tests. Each child will be made aware of how they will be sitting the test.

To make you aware of which tests they will be sitting on each day of the week, we have placed a timetable below.

Tuesday 9 th May	SPAG (Spelling, Punctuation and Grammar)
Wednesday 10 th May	English Reading
Thursday 11 th May	Mathematics Paper 1 & 2
Friday 12 th May	Mathematics Paper 3

To support the children as fully as we can, we are offering a free breakfast from 8:30am for all Year 6 children from Tuesday to Friday of SATs week, where they can have a bacon sandwich or toast.

We would like as many as possible to attend, as it will ensure they begin the day as prepared and as relaxed as possible. Children should come to the breakfast club door, through the front of school near reception.

We would like to take this opportunity to thank you all for your ongoing support this year, which we are sure will continue to do in ensuring the children are well rested, go to bed at a reasonable hour, as well as making sure they are prompt to school each morning.
