Dear Parents and Carers,

Re: Classes for September 2026 and Transition Morning

On **Thursday 2nd July 2026** we will be holding a transition morning in school where children will have the opportunity to 'move up' into their new classroom for September and meet their teacher. We know that children often find the prospect of moving up in September to be daunting, and so transition morning is important to help them feel settled when they come back to school after the summer break.

When they arrive for school on transition morning, children should be dropped off at their 'new' entrance to go straight into their new class. They will spend the morning with their new teacher and then return to their current classes for the afternoon session. At the end of the day, children should be picked up from their current class as normal.
